“Connecting Faith Communities” is a project of the Faith Communities Council of Victoria. This project aims to enhance interfaith work across Victoria, and is part of the Legacy of the 2009 Melbourne Parliament of the World’s Religions.

Applications are invited for a part-time Multifaith Project Officer to support this project. The position will be 3 days per week for 12 months, except during October and November when it is expected to be full time to enable the coordination of events to mark the first anniversary of the Melbourne Parliament of the World’s Religions (PWR). The position will be located in central Melbourne.

The major responsibilities of the Multifaith Project Officer will be to coordinate the PWR anniversary events, to maintain and develop a database, and to distribute information on a regular basis about multifaith and interfaith events and news.

Experience in the interfaith field and good interpersonal skills are mandatory, and it is expected that the successful applicant will be able to demonstrate experience in promoting interfaith and multifaith activities and relationships.
